

Royal Glenn “Roy” Waggoner Biographical Sketch¹

Roy Waggoner was born at Windom, McPherson County, Kansas on October 2, 1900. He was the fourth of the 13 children of John Franklin and Rosa Delaphine Waggoner².

He married Mary Oden on February 12, 1924. They lived in Rice County, Kansas. They had 7 children: Clarence Wayne (1924), Alfred Wilbert and Albert William – twins (1926) (Albert passed away when 9 months old), Clifford Eugene (1928), Luella May (1930), Royal Glenn (1939), and Harold Russell (1942).

Roy was a farmer and worked for the township maintaining roads.

Roy passed away in Sterling, Kansas on March 6, 1962. He is buried in the Lyons Municipal Cemetery, Lyons, Kansas.
